#### HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

As part of our 20-plus year

partnership with Habitat for Humanity, Raymond James sponsored its **12th full home build** in Pinellas County. To date, Raymond James Bank has also helped purchase **367** zero interest loans – representing **\$58.25 million** in loan balances – as part of the initiative.



### LOCAL IMPACT GIFTS

#### YMCA of Greater St. Petersburg

Raymond James supported the public-private partnership between Pinellas County Schools and the YMCA of Greater St. Petersburg to build a new middle school and YMCA. This collaborative engagement has helped to eliminate barriers to access and bring families from low- and high-income together, all while promoting health, education and social equity.

#### CASA: Family Justice Center

The Family Justice Center – a nationwide best-practice model for public health and safety – will bring comprehensive, collaborative, trauma-informed, free services together in one place. Raymond James provided support for the Mental Health Suite for survivors of domestic violence.

#### St. Pete City Theatre

This theatre is the oldest, continuously operating community theatre in Florida and has provided quality entertainment since 1925. Support from Raymond James is aiding capital improvements in honor of its 100th anniversary.

### Valor

Another successful Annual Golf Tournament fundraiser to support veteran communities, and over **\$465,000** donated to **31** nonprofit organizations since Valor's Inception in 2018.

Supported Dress for Success through clothing donations and continued support for USF's Women in Leadership and Philanthropy program.
