Eligibility criteria for ideal candidates:

- Be enrolled in an accredited university with a graduation date between December 2025 and June 2026
- Major in accounting, computer science, data science, economics, finance, information systems, marketing, management, math, sales, statistics, or any other business-related field
- ► Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- ► Be passionate about a career in financial services and working with diverse teams and customers

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

APPLY ONLINE

We have one common application for both programs. You will be able to select your preferred program and dates (Note: Sophomore Showcase events will have different locations and dates). The online application has two steps. First, you will submit your resume. You will then be asked to submit video responses to three questions. Applications for Sophomore Showcase will be considered on a rolling basis.

Students being considered for the Diversity Fast Track programs will also be asked to complete a brief virtual interview with a Raymond James team member. Decisions for the March Sophomore Showcase programs will be made by early March. All other program invitations will be made by the end of April.

Application deadline for all sophomore programs: March 1, 2024.
