## PLAN COST TAX CREDIT CREDIT # 1

The credit covers 100% of employers' ordinary and necessary out of pocket plan costs up to an annual limit for the first three years.

The annual limit is \$500, or if greater \$250 multiplied by the number of plan-eligible non-highly compensated employees (NHCEs), up to \$5,000.



## NHCE'S

OWNED 5% OR LESS OF THE EMPLOYER'S BUSINESS AT ANY TIME DURING THE YEAR OR PRECEDING YEAR. RECEIVED COMPENSATION FROM THE BUSINESS OF LESS THAN \$150,000(2023) IN THE PRECEDING YEAR.

## EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION TAX CREDIT CREDIT #2

The tax credit is a decreasing percentage of the amount contributed by the employer for each employee earning no more than \$100,000 per year, up to \$1,000 annually per employee, over the plans first five years.



## AUTOMATIC ENROLLMENT TAX CREDIT CREDIT # 3

Employers can also earn a tax credit for adding or, in the case of a startup plan, including the automatic enrollment feature as part of their plan.

The credit is \$500 per year for the first three years the feature is included.
