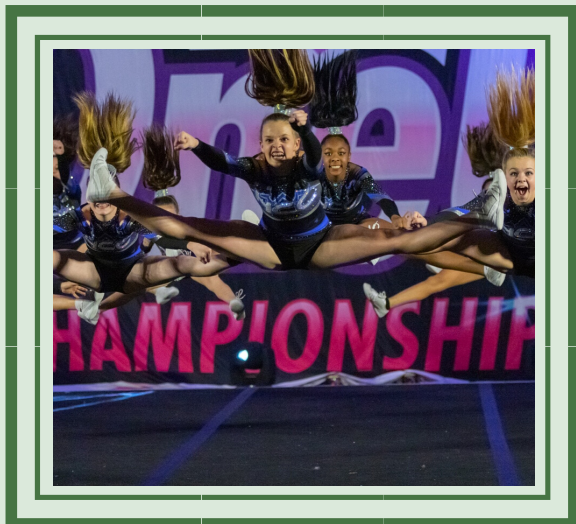

Hailey's cheer team took 1st place in their recent competition.

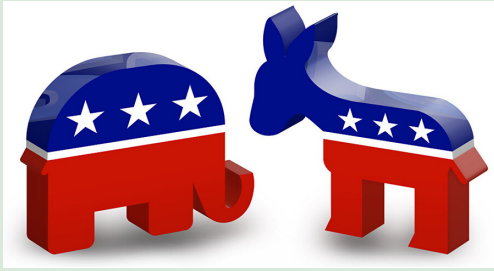


Gary and Hannah selecting spices at the Savory Spice Shop for a new popcorn flavor.
