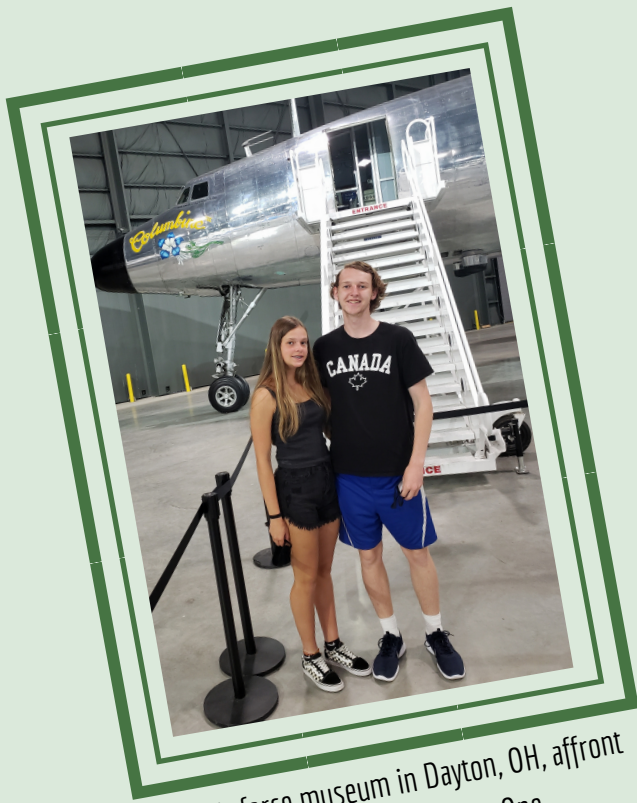

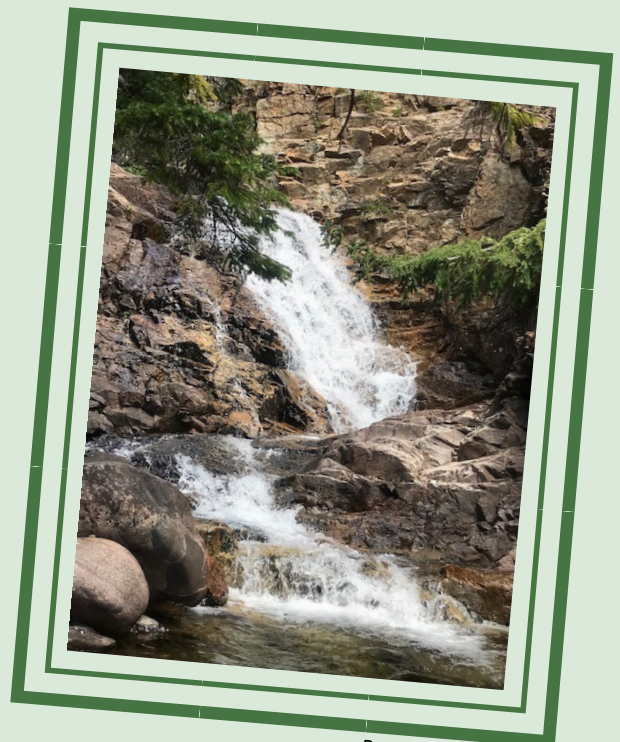

In uncertain times, a good meal with those we care about fuels a grateful heart. Check out this recipe rated 4/4:

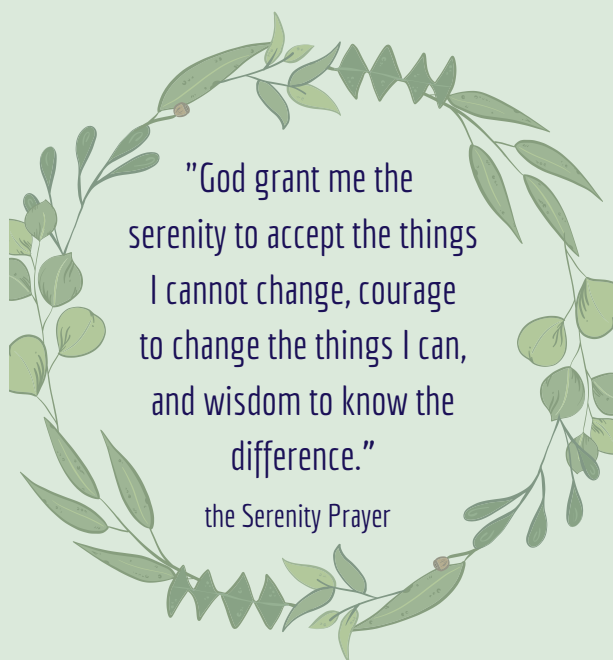
