

Education and Health Services Job Growth, Camden Metropolitan Area: 2005-2015





In the Camden Metropolitan Area, from 2005 to 2015, the Education and Health Services sector grew at an annual rate of 1.8%, adding 14,800 jobs.

In 2014 there were 507,810 individuals employed in the Camden Metropolitan area. Of these, 10.3% (52,226 individuals), worked in health care occupations.
